A LITTLE ABOUT US...

Welcome to the very first newsletter from North State Together! We hope to produce a quarterly newsletter, providing updates, progress reports, and useful information to those in our service area. But first, who, and what, are we?

North State Together (NST) is a new initiative that will support community collaborations in Tehama, Shasta, Trinity, Siskiyou, and Modoc counties. It is a \$2.5 million dollar, three year grant awarded by The McConnell Foundation. This grant will allow us to create a regional, “Cradle to Career” partnership where leaders from education, business, philanthropic, nonprofit, civic and faith communities join together to improve education success for every child through a data-driven, collective impact approach.

North State Together will provide direct funding to counties and also provide a “backbone support team” that will help existing and emerging collaborations in each county. This backbone support team consists of a dedicated staff who can plan, manage and support the partnerships through ongoing facilitation, technology and communications support, data collection and the many administrative details required to help the partnerships run smoothly. The backbone support team is lead by Chief Executive Officer, Dr. Kevin O’Rorke, with Dr. Kate Mahar serving as the Chief Learning and Research Officer, and Sharon Strazzo as Operations Manager.



CRADLE TO CAREER

“Cradle to Career Pathways” outline educational outcomes from early childhood through postsecondary education that will ensure that all students have access to quality education and viable careers.

Collective Impact refers to a theory of action where multiple stakeholders work together to achieve a common goal. As outlined by StriveTogether, the essential elements of collective impact include:

- A Shared Community Vision for Change
- Evidence Based Decision Making
- Collaborative Efforts Towards a Common Goal
- Leveraging of resources (human and financial) towards long term sustainability

North State Together will support Cradle to Career Pathways within each county using a collective impact framework to identify and implement local solutions for county-based goals and priorities.
